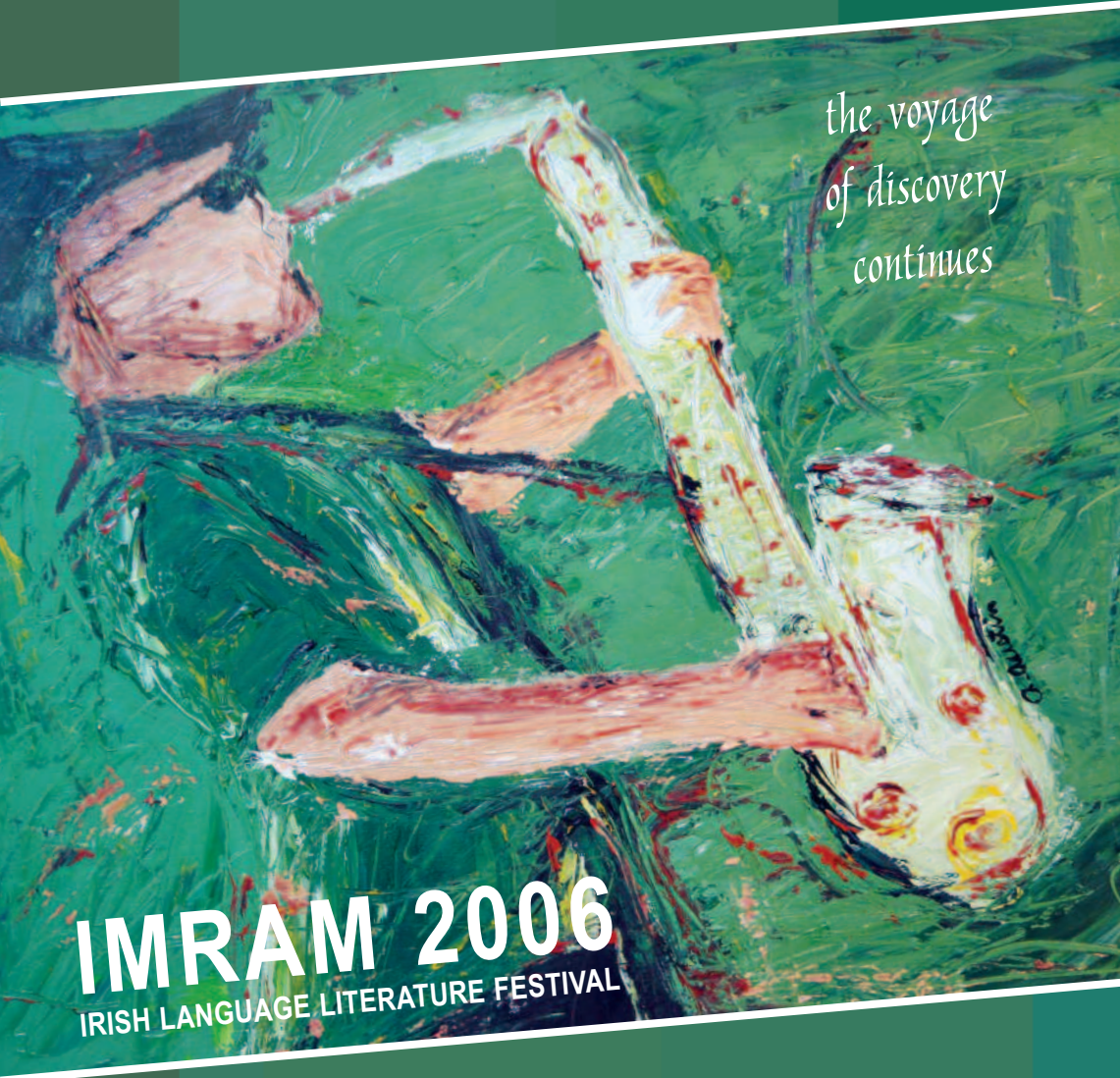

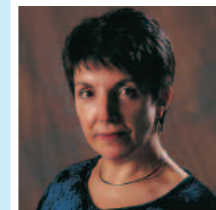

Harpist **Laoise Kelly** will accompany **Pádraigín** tonight. **Christine Primrose**, from the Isle of Lewis in the Outer Hebrides, has been singing traditional Gaelic song all her life. **Christine** has won many prizes at the **Mod** and the **Pan Celtic** festivals. Her albums include *Áite mo Ghaoil/Place of my Heart* and *Gun Sireadh, Gun Iarraidh/Without Seeking, Without Asking*.
